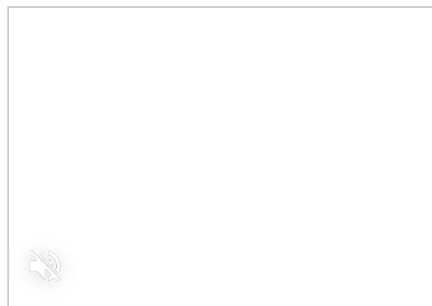


In the Accra Zone tournament, the Ghana Union of Traders Association beat the Ghana Institute of Freight Forwarders 5-4 in penalties after a goalless draw.

Both the GPHA Fire Team and GUTA received a trophy and a cash prize of GH¢10,000 each.

The second-placed teams in both the Tema and Accra Zones received a cash prize of GH¢5,000 each, while Wilmar and Manna FC, who placed third in the Tema and Accra zones respectively, received a cash prize of GH¢3,000 each.

The top scorer and best goalkeeper also received cash prizes.



Speaking to the media, Felix Segbaya, an Operations Officer at LCB Worldwide Ghana, stated that the tournament fulfilled the Country Manager's passion and commitment to sporting activities in the country.
